## Hooke's Law Experiment

**Objective:** To measure the spring constant of a spring using two different methods.

**Background:** If a weight  $W = mg$  is hung from one end of an ordinary spring, causing it to stretch a distance  $x$ , then an equal and opposite force,  $F$ , is exerted by the spring which opposes the pull of the weight. If  $W$  is not so large as to permanently stretch the spring, then the force  $F$ , will restore the spring to its original length after the load is removed. The magnitude of the restoring force is directly proportional to the stretch:

$$F = -kx$$

The constant  $k$  is called the spring constant. Its significance lies in the fact that it is the slope of the spring's graph. The steeper the slope is, the larger is the value of the spring constant.

$$F = -kx \rightarrow k = \frac{F}{x}$$

In addition to a graph, the value of  $k$  can be obtained by Hooke's Law and equation (1) below:

An ordinary spring is passive. This means that when forces are applied to it, there is motion under a force. "Hooke's Law" connecting force to the angle between forces, the passive force, can depend upon the magnitude of the resistance. For small angles, we have

$$F = kx/m$$

where  $k$  is the spring constant,  $F$  is the force of the resistance and  $x$  is the force that is causing it. This formula includes the mass of the spring itself. However, the mass of the spring does not affect with the angle subtended by the attached masses and therefore it is necessary to measure the effective length  $x$  of the spring from the end of the spring plus the contribution of the mass of the spring. Based on similar arguments, one third of the mass of the spring is a good approximation of the effective load due to the spring, that

$$x = x_{\text{eff}} + \frac{1}{3}M_{\text{spring}}$$

where  $x_{\text{eff}}$  is the effective load of the spring. Using this in Eq. (1), we find

$$F = kx_{\text{eff}} + \frac{1}{3}M_{\text{spring}}g$$

The effective load of the spring can be determined by connecting mass  $m$  to the spring.
